Welcome to 2008 Summer Theatre Arts for Kids™!

All sessions begin and end promptly! Our staff will not open doors until 9:20am and doors will close at 3:40pm to ensure our staff ample time to plan and prepare for the next day. You must pick your child up promptly.

Special Note: The 4th of July will be a short day to accommodate your holiday plans, but afford us the opportunity to not miss a day of rehearsal. We will meet from 9:30am – Noon. If you are unable to attend, please let Leah know as soon as possible.

Each day is filled with specific activities, keeping the students busy and focused. Because of this, all Theatre Arts For Kids™ sessions are closed to parents as we prepare for our big performances.

Students should wear comfortable clothes and closed-toed shoes. Come with a pencil and the binder you are given on Day 1. Students should bring a snack and drink daily, plus lunch.

A note of caution here: do not bring any food item which has nuts in it – sandwiches, candy, snacks with peanuts especially is a big no-no. We have students with nut/peanut allergies and want to keep them as safe as possible. Thank you for your understanding of this vital need.

Each student receives one DVD, and two (2) complimentary tickets to their session's final performance to be held at the Del Valle Theatre. These tickets will be handed out in the final week of class. Additional tickets (\$10 each) are available from RCA (Regional Center for the Arts) at 943-SHOW.

In addition, each student will receive one DVD containing all the photographs taken at their dress rehearsal, plus a copy of the free Head Shot taken during their session. An email notice will be sent to you as soon as the DVDs are ready for pickup. Head Shots may be picked up at the performance.

Please make sure that you have turned in a completed registration form, emergency form, and (optional) confidential form for each of your children in the program.

Rosters will be sent home on the first day of each session, and any additional information will be handed out as needed. **If for any reason you would like to not be included on the roster, please let me know right away!**
