Institute Rules

1. Keep the campgrounds clean, conserve water and recycle.
2. Show respect for directors, staff, instructors and those in charge of the facility.
3. Keep a positive attitude with fellow chorus members.
4. Have respect for fellow chorus members and their belongings. **DO NOT touch** or bother things that do not belong to you.
5. Do not leave **our area** at Silver Spur Camp or an activity without Director or adult permission and then only in two's.
6. No boys in the girl's dormitories – No girls in the boy's dormitory (Pool House)
7. Participate in all activities and all activity sessions must be promptly attended.
8. **Room assignments will not be changed** unless deemed necessary by the Institute director. **Choristers must sleep in assigned rooms** and keep room assignment sheet posted outside the room at all times.
9. Do not bring any hazardous materials i.e. matches, lighters, aerosol sprays, cigarettes etc.
10. Do not bring any knives or pocketknives to Summer Music Institute.
11. Do not bring any illegal substances to the Summer Music Institute.
12. Do not leave your dorm after lights out unless supervised by an adult. Lights out means sleep!

*If everyone follows these simple rules, everyone will have a great experience. Fortunately, almost all of our choristers follow the rules. We will not allow one person to endanger, disrupt or interfere with everyone's experience. **IF RULES ARE BROKEN, parents will be contacted and may be asked to come and take you home.***
